

The new cases include an adult woman and and adult man. Both are recovering at home.

While most COVID-19 patients in the county have been able to recover at home, one person remains hospitalized.

Sublette County Public Health reports that there are currently 5 people in isolation or quarantine in the Pinedale and Daniel areas.

COVID-19 TESTS

Patients experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 can call the Pinedale Clinic to schedule an appointment for a COVID-19 test. For those without insurance, call Public Health at 307-367-2157 to learn if you qualify for a free test voucher.

Although the clinics are not able to test those without symptoms at this time, plans are being made to be able to do so in the future.

ANTIBODY TESTS

Antibody testing is also being offered at both clinics in Sublette County. This test is to see if you have had the virus in the past. Call either clinic to schedule an appointment for the blood draw. The \$50 testing fee must be paid at the time of service.

HOSPITAL VISITATION

Most visitors are now prohibited at hospitals in the region (with limited exceptions) to protect staff and patients from the risk of COVID-19 transmission. This policy includes St. John's Health in Jackson, and Eastern Idaho Regional Medical Center facilities in Idaho Falls.
